#### **TDX TEST ENTRY FEE: \$150**

(Including \$.50 Recording Fee and \$3.00 AKC Event Service Fee)

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**ALL CHECKS AND MONEY ORDERS** are to be made payable to Burlington Obedience Training Club, Inc. **Payment must be in U.S. Funds. MAIL ENTRIES WITH FEES** to test Secretary. **Express mail entries must include signature permitting them to be left at the secretary's address without recipient's signature.**

**ENTRIES:** Fees must accompany entries. **No Fax service available.** It is suggested that you call or e-mail the test secretary to confirm the receipt of your entry.

**CLOSING DATE** for entries is 5:00 PM, Thursday, March 30, 2023, at the Trial Secretary's home, after which time entries cannot be canceled, accepted, or altered.

The **DRAWING** for entries in this Tracking Test will be held on Thursday, March 30, 2023, at 5:00 PM, at the Test Secretary's home. The drawing shall be random except that preference shall be given to those dogs that have not earned a TDX. There will be an alternate list, with positions assigned to the order in which they were drawn. The Test Secretary will notify all entrants of the results of the draw by email. Entrants may call the Test Secretary until 9:00 PM concerning the results of the drawing.

**WITHDRAWALS AND ENTRY FEE REFUNDS:** If an entry withdraws between the closing date and the test date and is replaced by an alternate, the entry fee will be refunded. Withdrawals must be made in writing to the Test Secretary. Entrants and alternates who do not run in a test but are replaced by an alternate who runs in the test shall have their full entry fee returned. Entry fees will not be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a judge, or barred from competition. by action of the Test Committee. Note: tests may be canceled or rescheduled in the event of extreme weather conditions. The Test Secretary reserves the right to enter this test.

**BITCHES IN SEASON** will be allowed to participate after all other dogs and bitches have been tested. They will be allowed on the tracking field only immediately prior to the running of their track.

## TROPHIES

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**TRACKING TEST EXCELLENT TROPHIES:** The Burlington Obedience Training Club offers a dark green rosette and signed Tracking glove.

### DIRECTIONS TO THE TEST SITE:

**From the South or North:** Interstate I-89 north to Exit 17, exiting onto US Route 2 West toward the Champlain Islands. Follow Route 2 for about 15 minutes. After the village of Keller Bay, in 3 miles Turn left onto Allen Road ((Industrial Park sign on your right, white house on the left corner. Approximately 300 feet from that corner on the right, 6 Allen Road is a white farmhouse with red barn out back, chain link fence along the road front.

**Alternate Route from the North:** Follow US Route 2 East through the Champlain Islands to the Town of Grand Isle. Approximately 2 miles from Grand Isle village, on the right is Allen Road. Turn right onto Allen Road to #6, on the right, 300 ft. from that corner..

**From the Grand Isle Ferry Dock:** Turn left when you exit the Ferry Dock. Continue on Route 314 for approximately 1 mile. After the curve in the road that bears right continue on Route 314 (Allen Road) for 2 miles. 6 Allen Road will be on your left BEFORE you get back to Route 2.

## INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels(King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

2. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering our dog, i.e., A or B division.

3. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3. of the *Rules Applying to Dog Shows*.)

4. Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine Partners<sup>SM</sup> Program** may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC Obedience trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC Number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box. Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.
